COVID 19 GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

Do Not Attend the Game If...

- The player has symptoms relating to Covid-19 (fever, runny nose, cough, sore throat, etc.)
- The player or player's family member has tested positive for the Coronavirus and has not been cleared by way of a negative test.

Pre-Game

- When players arrive, they should wait outside the building until a coach or staff member signals that teams can enter.
- Players should wash hands or use hand sanitizer upon entry into the facility.

Game Play

- Players should keep their water bottle clearly labeled and distant from others.
- Players should avoid contact with teammates, opponents, referees, and coaches when possible.

Post-Game

- Players should follow the lead of coaches as it pertains to post-game sportsmanship.
- Players and families should immediately exit the facility when the game has ended.

CASE REPORTING GUIDELINES

- If a family discovers a positive case of Covid-19 within their immediate family, the family should take the following steps:
 - Notify the coach and the league ASAP. (league email: info@uscoreindoor.com)
 - Begin quarantine as recommended by the CDC.
- When uScore Soccer is alerted to a case of Covid-19, the following steps will be taken:
 - Participants who may have encountered the affected individual will be notified by email.
 - Any game postponements or adjustments will be communicated as soon as they are finalized.

SPECTATOR POLICIES

- Because uScore will only use 2 of 3 game fields at any given time, we will allow 2 adult spectators (with face coverings) per player.
- Any siblings over the age of 10 must wear a face covering. All siblings must sit with parents for the duration of the game and are not permitted to roam the building.
- Families should respect the social distance of others when selecting seats.
- We encourage individuals with underlying health conditions to stay home.

FACILITY PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

- uScore Soccer continues to clean high contact surfaces regularly.
- Vests are single use.
- Game times will be staggered.
- Coaches are encouraged, but not required, to wear masks.
- Referees may choose to wear a mask.
- uScore Soccer will follow recommendations of local and county officials as it pertains to public safety.
